### Voting at the Polling Station on 2 May - identity documents need to be presented

To vote at the polling station for this year's elections you will only need to show one form of photo ID. It needs to be the original version and not a photocopy (please note that these new rules do not apply to postal votes).

Acceptable forms of identity for this purpose include:

- Passport issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, a British Overseas Territory, an EEA state or a Commonwealth country
- Driving licence issued by the UK, any of the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, or an EEA state (as long as it is not one of the old form licences without a photo on it it has to have a photo on it)
- A Blue Badge
- Older Person's Bus Pass
- Disabled Person's Bus Pass
- Freedom Pass
- Identity card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram (a PASS card)
- Biometric immigration document
- Ministry of Defence Form 90 (Defence Identity Card)
- National identity card issued by an EEA state
