Jen Read

We are delighted to announce that Jen Read has been licensed to St James Silsden as a Licensed Lay Minister.

Licensed Lay Ministers are the equivalent to what was previously known as a Reader. Both carry a Bishop's License, and are recognised nationally throughout the Church of England as of equal status and training.

You will have seen Jen at church over the past few months and she has preached at a 9.30am service. We are also grateful that she is part of the team hosting and leading the Alpha course at the moment.

Jen is married to Daniel, whose guitar playing has been blessing our Gathering and 11am services.

It was in 2014 that Jen felt called to be a Lay Reader (as it was called at the time) and trained for 3 years before being licensed as a Lay Minister to St John's Yeadon in September 2017.

Now that Jen and Daniel have come to live in this part of the world, and have been led to worship at St James, then it is to St James Silsden that Jen's licence now applies.

We are thankful for this and Jen will be formally commissioned to St James Silsden at our Sunday morning services on 17 November.
